

Skyline Family, here are some things you need to know:

We ask that you wear a mask to worship, during worship, and after worship. IF YOU FEEL SICK OR HAVE BEEN AROUND SOMEONE WHO HAS BEEN SICK, PLEASE STAY HOME AND WORSHIP WITH US IN SPIRIT AND ONLINE. We will continue to stream the worship service online Facebook at 10 AM each Sunday morning. We are trusting your judgment. You are responsible for making decisions for you and your family.

It's ok to not be ready to come back to corporate worship. If you have questions regarding whether or not you should return, please call the church office and we will walk through the risks with you and help you reach a decision.

- Please observe the wristbands people will be wearing and be respectful of everyone's wishes. If someone doesn't want to be hugged, please respect that decision. Be courteous and love each other. Wristbands are available in the lobby.
- The chairs have been rearranged to accommodate social distancing. We are asking that families set together during worship.
- There will be no Sunday AM classes nor Wednesday PM classes.
- There will be no SkyKids. The nursery will be closed. The nursing room will be available for changing and nursing children. The playground will be available if it's sunny and your child needs to burn some energy. Let me state this as best I can. Families, we want you to bring your children. We do not want you to stay home because you're worried about your child distracting anyone. We're a family, and part of being a family is that we love our children. Part of being a child is there is a certain level of activity needed and noise that comes along with that need to be active. We'll not only deal with it, but we will welcome it.
- Communion will be provided. But if you would like to bring your own, that is fine.
- Bathrooms will be open. We ask that you wash your hands before exiting and that you use the hand sanitizer available.
- There will be no Coffee Bar or use of water fountains. We will have bottled water available if you would like to have one.
- We will still observe the time in our worship we call Four Corners, and it will be conducted in the same fashion. Elders will be wearing masks during Four Corners.
- There will be baskets for your offering if you choose to bring it. You may drop your offering in the baskets on the way out. Otherwise, you may continue to mail them or give online.
